

WORSHIP DIRECTOR

GENERAL:

The Worship Director at The River Church Community is responsible for facilitating and leading the Sunday morning worship life. This includes scheduling and vision for the worship band, arranging and planning sets (with the support of the Sunday Planning Team), running rehearsals and team building for the band. The Worship Director will also lead and/or assist in other River worship events and creative arts projects as directed and able.

This position can range from 20-40 hrs/week, *contingent on the abilities and capacities of the candidate*. The Worship Director shall report to the Executive Pastor, and work closely with the Lead Pastor and the Production Director.

Duties include but are not limited to:

Vision & Administration of Worship Team Vision & Collaboration with the Tech Team Recruitment and Integration of new Worship Team Members Participation with Staff Team (Staff Meetings, Exec Pastor Meetings, Staff Events) Sunday Worship Planning (w/ the Production Director and Teaching Team) Worship Team Nights Coaching and Mentoring of Leaders, and the Leaders of Youth Band Creative Art Events Assisting with All Staff Special Events and other duties as needed.

Additional duties possible contingent on the candidate:

Communications (Visual, writing, branding, social media) Building and leveraging the Creative Arts community for missional / outreach Pastoral Care of Adults Teaching & Spiritual Formation

Attributes & Skills Required:

The Worship Director should have an authentic and meaningful faith life and relationship with Jesus that resonates with The River's statement of faith and spiritual culture. The Worship Director needs to be gifted and skilled musically, with a particular desire towards being able to

- Incorporate, mentor and grow the musicianship of the worship team, along with a receptivity and flexibility to the presence of God's Spirit in worship and for the pastoral and communal needs of the church
- 2. Be versatile musically, able to incorporate a variety of musical styles and traditions, and be able to effectively lead The River in a gradual movement towards a growing **multiethnic** and **multigenerational** expression of music worship, and
- 3. Integrate the worship life of the church with the **missional** expression of the church.
- 4. Be conversant and informed both **theologically** and **liturgically**, in order to blend the spontaneity of modern worship with the basic rhythms and themes of the church calendar to form The River's eclectic and dynamic worship gatherings.

The Worship Director will be required to be a **good teammate** to the staff, volunteer worship and prayer teams, desire feedback, desire personal and professional growth, and can have fun.
